

Example: Let's Solve Together!

Problem: Maria has 8 red apples. Her friend gives her 5 green apples. How many apples does Maria have now?

1. Draw a Picture



2. Write a Number Sentence

$$8 + 5 = 13$$

3. Write the Answer

Answer: Maria has 13 apples in total. We add the two groups of apples (8 and 5) to find the total amount.

Leo has 5 red apples. His mom gives him 4 more green apples. How many apples does Leo have in all?
